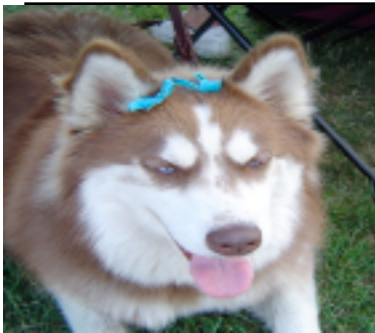
Foxy (b/w) Nilla (white)

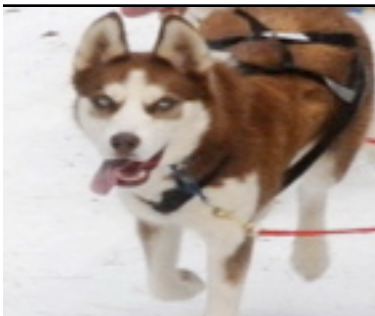
Bowser
